Prosecco Vaporetto, Veneto, Italy

NV – With flavours of apple and hints of apricot and citrus. It also has floral notes of white and meadow flowers, with a fresh finish.

Sparkling Rosé Le Colture Brut, Veneto, Italy

NV – Made by prestigious Le Colture family estate, this hand-made sparkling rose wine is the perfect party pink!

Ridgeview, Sussex, England

NV – Crisp with citrus fruit aromas with hints of melon and honey. The Pinots add depth and character leading to a beautifully balanced finish.

CHAMPAGNE

Taittinger Brut La Francaise, Reims

NV – Light, fresh and balanced with a green fruit and citrus character rounded by subtle hints of biscuit and brioche on the palate.

Taittinger Brut Rosé Cuvée Prestige, Reims

NV – Notes of crushed wild raspberry and cherry, with creamy flavours on the finish.

El Campesino Unoaked Chardonnay, Central Valley, Chile

2018 – A lively wine with bright stone fruit and a touch of creaminess on the palate.

Pinot Grigio Luna, Cecilia Beretta, Veneto

2017 – Has true varietal character, showing floral and almond notes, with ripe citrus fruit and a subtle minerality.

Chenin Blanc Stellenrust, Stellenbosch, South Africa

2017 – Apple, peach and starfruit flavours fuse with subtle asian spices.

Fiano Masseria Bianca, Puglia, Italy

2015 – Fresh tasting and well texture with some interesting flavours of tropical fruits and a hint of nutty flavour.

Ana Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand

2017 – A typical Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with cut grass aromas, gooseberry flavours and refreshing citric acidity.

Weitgasse Grüner-Veltliner Mantlerhof, Kremstal, Austria

2017 – An intense, concentrated Grüner, with stunning fruit flavours and beautifully balanced acidity.

Kung Fu Girl Riesling, Charles Smith Wines, Washington, USA

2016 – Aromatic Riesling with flavours of apricot, key lime and nectarine. Medium-bodied, with a crisp, long finish.

Block 2 Pinot Gris, The Lane, Adelaide Hills, Australia

2017 – Fresh with flavours of apricot, key lime and nectarine. Medium-bodied, with a crisp, long finish.

WINES BY THE GLASS

RED WINE

Marques de la Musa Tempranillo Garnacha Carinena Bodegas San Valero, Spain

2017 – Is a fruit-forward and refreshing red coming from Aragón, at the foothills of the Spanish Pyrénées.

Cabernet Sauvignon Dominio del Toyo, La Rioja, Famatina Valley, Argentina

2017 – Fruity nose showing aromas of gooseberry and black cherry, soft spices and a dark chocolate bite.

Merlot Belvedere Cecilia Beretta, Veneto, Italy

2017 – Opens up with the typical freshness of north Italy merlot with velvety tannins and a smooth, milk chocolate finish.

Cabernet Franc / Merlot, Malatinszki Organic Wine Estate, Villany, Hungary

2014 – Juicy and fleshy on the palate with aromas of plum, black cherry and mulderberry with hints of Mediterranean spices.

Pinotage, Rhebokskloof Wine Estate, Paarl, South Africa

2015 – This Pinotage offers dark ripe fruit, subtle smoke and ash.

Tomero Malbec, Bodega Vistalba, Mendoza, Argentina

2016 – It has aromas of ripe prunes, dry fruits and licorice, with subtle notes of vanilla seeds and floral characters. An elegant well structured Malbec.

Battle of Bosworth Puritan Shiraz, South Australia

2017 – Aromas and flavours of damson, blueberries and dark chocolate. It's a full-bodied red wine, with a smooth texture.

Pinot Noir Eradus, Marlborough, New Zealand

2017 – Bouquet of ripe raspberry, black olive and mocha, combined with a fresh touch of green herbs.

ROSÉ WINE

Filarino Sangiovese Rosato Rubicone IGT, Emilia Romagna, Italy

2017 – A bright, floral and fruity Sangiovese based rosé. This will handle spice and ripe flavours very well.

Petale de Rose, Château la Tour de l'Eveque, Côtes de Provence, France

2017 – Aroma of pear and green apple combined with raspberry and cherry. An interesting balsamic note on the finish.

DESSERT WINE

Pacherenc du Vic Bilh Saint Albert, France – 750ml

2014 – This sweet wine offers rich, concentrated flavours, with notes of marmalade and caramel coated tropical fruits, lifted by a fine citric acidity.

Sticky Mickey Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc, Eradus, Marlborough, NZ – 375ml

Vintage 2017 – Scents of orange blossom, apricot and honey. The palate shows tropical fruits, a taste of melon and beautiful limey acidity

Riesling Ice Wine, Stratus Vineyards, Niagara, Canada – 375ml

2016 – Crisp and stylish with white flowers aroma and a taste of citrus grapefruit and green apple.

Tokaji Blue Label Aszu, 5 Puttonyos, Barta, Hungary – 500ml

2014 – Nose of orange peel, figs and cinnamon. Well balanced and clean finish.

PORT

10 Years Old Tawny Port, Quinta do Vallado, Portugal – 500ml

NV – Rich, nutty with dried fruit aromas. Hints of chocolate, spices and dates.

Graham LBV Port, Portugal – 750ml

2012 – Ripe red cherry on the nose with dried fruits. Inviting and warm.

SPARKLING

Prosecco Vaporetto, Veneto, Italy

NV – With flavours of apple and hints of apricot and citrus. It also has floral notes of white and meadow flowers, with a fresh finish.

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Ridgeview, Sussex, England

NV – Crisp with citrus fruit aromas with hints of melon and honey. The Pinots add depth and character leading to a beautifully balanced finish.

CHAMPAGNE

Brut Reserve, Henri Benoit, Reims

NV – An elegant and delightful champagne with white blossom and citrus lime notes.

Taittinger Brut La Française, Reims

NV – Light, fresh and balanced with a green fruit and citrus character rounded by subtle hints of biscuit and brioche on the palate.

Nocturne, Taittinger, Reims

NV – It is all about smoothness and creaminess, revealing aromas of white flowers and ripe fruit. Hints of yellow peaches and apricots on the palate.

Louis Roederer Brut Premier, Reims

NV – Harmonious and structured, elegant and lively, with a unique exuberancy. It is a full, complex wine that is both rich and powerful, whilst remaining a great classic.

Bollinger Special Cuvée, Aÿ

NV – Ripe fruit and spicy aromas ; hints of roasted apples, apple compote and peaches. On the palate a subtle combination of structure with hints of pear, brioche and spicy aromas, notes of fresh walnut.

Ruinart Blanc de Blancs, Reims

NV – A very unique champagne that combines the sweetness of stone fruits and tropical fruits balance by a hint of toast brioche and remarkable minerality.

Comtes de Champagne Blanc de Blancs, Taittinger, Reims

2007 – Grapes are sorted from Grands Crus vineyards and later the bottles undergoes at least 8 years of maturation on the cellars. It is a full and rounded champagne with delicate minerality and a salty citrus kick.

Krug Grand Cuvée, Reims

NV – Notes of toasted bread, hazelnut, nougat, barley sugar and jellied fruits may take you by surprise. You may even taste hints of apples still on the tree, flowers in bloom, ripe and dried fruit.

Louis Roederer Cristal, Reims

2008 – Its unique energy and surprising depth. Its pure tension, opulence and remarkable persistence take it above and beyond any limits. Cristal 2008 is the embodiment of this concentration, intensity, energy and complexity.

CHAMPAGNE ROSÉ

Taittinger Brut Rosé Cuvée Prestige, Reims

NV – Notes of crushed wild raspberry and cherry, with creamy flavours on the finish.

Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut, Reims

NV – Light and elegant with a delicate mousse. Aromas of white flowers and red fruits combined with a salted caramel aftertaste.

Le Troubadour Ugni Blanc Colombard, Languedoc-Roussillon

2017 – Light and fresh with white fruits and peach notes and a floral character.

Picpoul de Pinet Domaine de Morin Langaran, Languedoc

2017 – Flavours of stone fruits and juicy citrus with a hint of acacia flower.

Gewürztraminer Cave de Cleebourg, Alsace

2017 – Exotic and elegant Gewürztraminer shows delicate spice with ripe lychee and lemongrass notes.

Bourgogne Aligoté, Olivier Leflaive, Burgundy

2016 – The usual light lemon-cream character of aligote but with an extra dimension richness.

Chablis Domaine Vincent Damp, Yonne, Burgundy

2017 – Expressive with aromas of white fruit and citrus, crush mineral and soft herbs on the palate.

Côtes-du-Rhône Blanc Guy Louis Tardieu-Laurent, Rhône Valley

2016 – Shows a unique peach skin grip. 100% barrel fermented, it is then aged for eight months in new and old barrels. A great combination of aromatic character and richness.

Le Faite Blanc, Saint Mont, Plaimont, South West

2014 – This generous wine displays rich tropical and apricot flavours, a light floral note and a pronounced mineral element, almost saline.

Meursault Cuvée Charles Maxime Latour Giraud, Côtes du Beaume, Burgundy

2016 – A very attractive nose of white pear and melon with smoky and nutty richness on the palate.

Chablis Grand Cru Bougros Maison Damp, Yonne, Burgundy

2017 – It evokes warm pastry notes, apple tart and vanilla cream, balance by tropical fruit aromas and sweet peach.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc Château de Beaucastel, South Rhône

2010 – Complex with elegant minerality and subtle spices.

ITALY

Pinot Grigio Luna, Cecilia Beretta, Veneto

2017 – Has true varietal character, showing floral and almond notes, with ripe citrus fruit and a subtle minerality.

2016 – Floral scents of acacia elderflower, a sweet taste of quince paste and bitter almond finish.

2016 – Delicate and intense with inviting fragrance, white and citrus fruit flavours with a herbaceous finish.

Soave Classico Monte Carbonare Suavia, Valpolicella

2016 – Sharp mineral notes from the volcano soil, floral and tangy.

Alois Lageder Porer Pinot Grigio, Veneto

Eric Louis Pinot Noir, Loire Valley

2016 – Elegant, smooth and highly drinkable now, with a satisfying depth and ripeness of dark cherry and raspberry fruit intensified by its juicy acidity

Côtes-du-Rhône Villages Les Becs Fins Tardieu-Laurent, Rhône Valley

2016 – Raspberry, blueberry, cassis and damson, with a hint of figginess. Crunchy phenolic tannins, with bright resonant red cherry fruit.

Moulin-a-Vent Coeur de Terroir Vieilles Vignes Domaine Labruyere B, Beaujolais

2016 – The palate is ripe and supple, with resounding raspberry fruit. Very elegant Beaujolais, perfectly balance earthiness and fruitness.

Crozes-Hermitage Vieilles Vignes Tardieu-Laurent, North Rhône

2014 – A great fresh expression of Syrah with menthol and peppery nose. The palate is sinewy, herbaceous, dark-fruited and admirably fine. minty and peppery. The palate is sinewy, herbaceous, dark-fruited and admirably fine.

Cornas Cuvée Charlemagne Cave Dumazet, North Rhône

2012 – Meaty and gamey, with loads of olive tapanade, pepper and spiced dark fruits aromas and flavours.

2015 –Delicate and appealingly aromatic; delivers notes of red fruits, cinnamon and menthol.

Château Lagrange a Pomerol, Bordeaux

2014 – Full body and meaty with polish tannins. Plum and blackberry aromas merge with tobacco pipe, leather and crack pepper.

Morey St Denis Domaine Michel Magnien, Côtes de Nuits, Burgundy

2014 – Elegant, outstanding, single vineyard Pinot Noir from the Biodynamic icon, Michel Magnien!

Château Beauregard, Pomerol, Bordeaux

2009 – Opulent nose of black berry, black currant and warm spices -an indication of excellent ripeness. Very well integrated fresh and toasty oak

Château La Lagune, 3 Grand Cru Classe, Haut Medoc

2011 – The nose is fine, fruity and ripe while at the same time powerful and noble. The palate is filled with fresh, bright fruit flavors resting on an extremely supply mouth.

Château Pontet-Canet, 5 Grand Cru Classe, Pauillac

2005 – Loads of pure blueberry, blackberry and cassis fruit are present along with a hint of licorice and background oak.

Château Gruaud Larose, 2 Grand Cru Classe, Saint Julien

1986 – Delicate and fragrant nose. Blackberries and black tea flavors. Fruit is still very much alive with a good backbone of acidity.

Château Palmer, 3 Grand Cru Classe, Margaux

2003 – Dark ripe fruits such as plum and blackberry. Scents of vanilla, black tea and mocha. Superb balance and velvety tannins.

Château Lynch-Bages, 5 Grand Cru Classe, Pauillac

1989 – Notes of creme de cassis, subtle smoke, oak and graphite. Powerful and rich with polished tannins.

Château La Mission Haut-Brion, Pessac Leognan

2010 – Stunning aromas of ripe, berry fruits leap from the glass, while on the palate there is an almost chocolate texture from the superbly ripe tannins and viscous layer of fruit.

Legato Nero d'Avola, Sicily

2017 – This wine has an intense spicy, cherry aroma with rich, ripe dark fruit flavours.

Merlot Belvedere Cecilia Beretta, Veneto

2017 – Opens up with the typical freshness of north Italy merlot with velvety tannins and a smooth, milk chocolate finish.

2016 – Black cherry, raspberry and hints of blueberries and minerals. An unoaked wine with soft tannins, moderate acidity and good balance.

Dolcetto d'Alba Bruno Giacosa, Langue, Piemonte

2017 – A savoury and fruity red with scents of raspberries and morello cherry with a floral hint of red roses.

Paolo Conterno Barolo Riva del Bric, Langhe, Piemonte

2014 – Aromas and flavours of plums, ripe red cherry and liquorice. This wine is smooth and well-balanced.

Talenti Brunello di Montalcino, Tuscany

2013 – A full-bodied, rich red wine with flavours of chocolate, savoury black cherry and bramble fruit, with a crisp finish.

Le Serre Nuove Tenuta dell'Ornellaia, Bolgheri, Tuscany

2015 – Full bodied with notes of violet and lavender blend with a flavour of dark berries and cacao. Great persistence and bold tannins.

2013 – Delicate, fragrant and floral with berried fruit underscored by crushed stone mineral.

Spätburgunder, Weingut Kopp, Baden
2015 – Powerful but not rich on the palate, with perfectly integrated tannins and elegant structure in the aftertaste.

Velvet Devil Merlot, Charles Smith Wines, Washington
2016 – Aromas of drak cherry, plum, cassis and tobacco. Medium bodied with polish tannins and a peppery finale.

Dry Creek Vineyards Heritage Zinfandel, Sonoma, California
2016 – Aromas and flavours of ripe blackberry, blueberry and raspberry accompanied by warm spices, with a smooth mouthfeel and a refreshing finish.

Twelve Clones Pinot Noir, Morgan, Sonoma, California
2016 – This beautiful red wine has aromas and flavours of plum, dark chocolate and cocoa. Medium-bodied and well-balanced.

Craggy Range Le Sol Syrah, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand
2015 – Complex brooding Syrah aromatics of boysenberry, black pepper, camphor and garrigue herbs. The palate is all about finesse with dark fruit richness.

ARGENTINA AND CHILE

Cabernet Sauvignon Dominio del Toyo, La Rioja, Famatina Valley, Argentina
2017 – Fruity nose showing aromas of gooseberry and black cherry, soft spices and a dark chocolate bite.

Santa Rita Gran Hacienda Carmenere, Central Valley, Chile
2016 – On the nose it has aromas of black and red fruits, with spices. Its silky tannins make it a very versatile to pair with a wide variety of foods.

Cabernet Sauvignon / Merlot, Tilia, Mendoza, Argentina
2017 – Shows fragrance and flavours of plum and raspberry, with light notes of spices such as clove and black pepper. The mouthfeel is soft and smooth.

Tomero Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina
2016 – It has aromas of ripe prunes, dry fruits and licorice, with subtle notes of vanilla seeds and floral characters. An elegant well strcutured Malbec.

Malbec Bodega Ruca Malen, Mendoza, Argentina
2015 – Grown at high altitudes that concentrate flavour and aroma in the grapes, is a complex and intense wine with exceptional freshness and plenty of dark, spicy fruits.

Journeys End The Pastors Blend Cab Merlot, Stellenbosch
2016 – A fresh, fruit forward Bordeaux blend from Stellenbosch. Bright and drinkable!
